			Available as a daytime, evening or weekend program. For students interested in areas such as: Chemistry, Chiropractic, Medical Technology, Pharmacy, Physical Sciences, Physical Therapy, Physics, Toxicology, and other areas as well. Completion of NCC degree prepares students for transfer into third year at most senior colleges.
			For students looking to transfer to a 4-year college.
			For career-oriented students.
			Student must be ready for Calculus 1 their frst semester in the program by 1) placement, or 2) transfer credit of Pre-Calculus or higher level math with at least a C, or 3) successful completion of MAT 111: Pre-Calculus with at least a C prior to start of program.

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Fall admission only. No evening program.

Freshmen: Grades of 75 or above in high school biology, chemistry, and 2 years of college preparatory math.
Transfers: Grade of C+ or better in Anatomy & Physiology 1 and currently enrolled in, or completion of, Anatomy & Physiology 2. If an applicant does not have Anatomy & Physiology, two Science majors' course such as biology, chemistry or physics, with grades of C+ or better, may be substituted. Completion of at least 12 liberal arts credits, with GPA of 2.5 or above, from the PTA program. If chemistry was not taken in high school, a semester of introductory college chemistry is required, and may be counted as part of the required "12 liberal arts credits". All transfer applicants must be in good academic standing at previous college.

All Applicants: Ten hours or more of volunteer or paid experience in a physical therapy facility; written proof, from a PT or PTA, on official facility letterhead stationery, must be submitted as part of the application. Interview required. Placement in remediation will remove applicant from consideration. Some accepted students may have to take courses prior to their first semester. Placement in remediation will remove applicant from consideration.

Satisfying the minimum admissions requirement does not guarantee acceptance to the program.

Fall admission only. No evening program.

Freshmen: Cumulative high school GPA of at least 77. Grades of at least 75 in biology, chemistry or physics, and 2 years of college preparatory math.

Transfers: Recommend completion of NCC's ENG 101, MAT 109, a 4-credit laboratory science (preferably Anatomy & Physiology 1). Overall GPA of 2.8 or above.

Freshmen: Upper 50% of h.s. class. 2 years science (chosen from biology, chemistry, physics); 2 years college preparatory math; minimum grades of 75 in science and math. NCC Students/Transfers: Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA. It is recommended that transfer students take at least 16 credits in courses required for the program, including ENG 101, MAT elective, and A&P 1 (within last 5 years). All applicants: Interview required. Criminal background check and random drug testing required prior to course registration. Must be legally eligible for licensure and employment in the United States at the time of application. Placement in remediation may remove applicant from consideration.
